It can be a hard job teaching our child to listen but one sure way to do it is to role model what you would like to see. Teach your child to listen by actively listening to them.

There are things you can do that might help -

1. Speak to the child without multitasking as you talk.

2. Use fewer words, be clear what you are saying without too much emotion. Be Calm.

3. See it from her point of view. Show empathy e.g " I can see you are tired however I need you to....."

4. Don't keep repeating yourself. If you've asked once and not gotten a response, don't just repeat yourself. Have a consequence e.g, "Can you tidy your toys? If you tidy them now you will be able to play again later." Follow through.

5. Engage cooperation e.g doing joint tasks like cooking.

6. Set up routines for behaviours you want.

My child never listens to me, even if I repeat myself! How can I get her to listen?

7. Catch them being good!

Hi everyone, I'm Hannah and I'm a Key Worker with Sharing Parenting.

Having a one to one Key Worker really makes a difference in giving people the confidence and tools they need to reach their goals. I'm also a qualified life coach and a lot of what I do during one to one sessions uses these skills as well.

I first joined Sharing Parenting 3 years ago as an administrator and have learnt so much.

I would encourage EVERYONE to get parenting support as it's no easy 'job'! I've been a single parent for 7 years now; I have two children, a 10 and 8 year old, and I frequently rely on the strategies we advocate to get me through those 'new' challenges!

Finding parenting hard is **NORMAL** and we are all doing the best we can with what we have. There is definitely no harm in seeking out support from other parents.

For me though, the **best thing about being a parent is when your** children talk openly to you about what's important to them and they reflect back to you life skills they have taken on board from you....because actually it proves they **DO listen**!!
