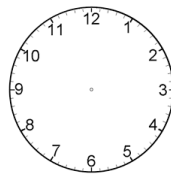
Let's get started!

11. What colours are on the doors steps of Ozzies?

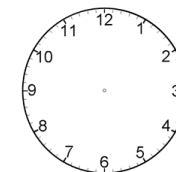
Make a u turn and start heading back towards the Market Hill.

15. Finally record your finishing **time here!**

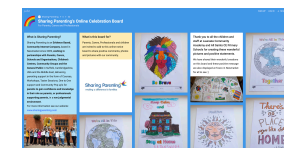
