- You do not need to go into any shop or make a purchase to complete this treasure hunt, however IF you are going shopping at the same time remember you are required to wear a mask in the shops.
- There is no time limit on the treasure hunt as this will vary depending on the age and abilities of your children. Please note if this is after 4.00pm please contact Sharing Parenting for your goody bag.



Let's get started!



Go to the starting point which is **by the play park near Red Lodge Sports Pavilion (IP28 8FQ).**

Take a selfie of you and your group ☺

- 1) Who provided and manages the play park?
- 2) How many sections does the sports statue on top of the hill have?
- 3) What is the name of the American Football Team mentioned on the poster on the green fence?
- 4) What food is mentioned on the yellow box attached to the lamppost near the Sports Pavilion?
- 5) On the menu poster found in a window, how much is a hot chocolate with marshmallow and cream at the pavilion café?
- 6) Where do you find the fire assembly point green sign?

***Walk back towards the play park.**

- 7) What sport involving a table can you play by the park?

***Walk down the path past the car park.**

8) On the red post box, what time is the post collected on Monday to Friday?

9) At the bus shelter, according to the timetable, what is the number of the bus which travels from Mildenhall – Red Lodge – Bury St Edmunds?

***Walk towards the school and safely cross the road.**

10) What is the name of the nursery mentioned on the banner?

***Stay on this side of the road and walk up to the other bus shelter and turn right onto the path next to it. Walk down this path and turn left half-way down towards the Fish Bar.**

11) What time is Red Lodge Fish Bar open on a Tuesday?

12) How much is a fringe cut at Cutting Edge hair salon?

13) What fruit is on the poster window at Nisa Local?

***Turn left at Lodge Lettings and follow the path round then walk to the end of the road (Fennel Drive) and turn left to head back towards the play park.**

14) What is the number on the lamppost you come to first along the path?

15) On the Red Lodge Parish Council Notice Board (by the car park), when does it say the Pop Up café is open?

***Walk back to the play park to collect your 'treasure'**

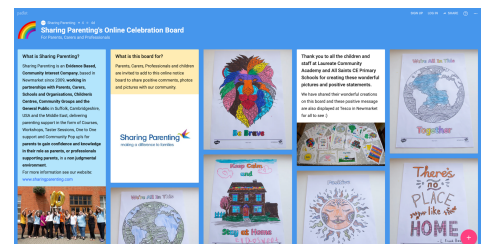
