***Cross over Mill Road and continue forward.**

- 7) What time is Lakenheath Library open on a Thursday?
- 8) What road does St Mary's Mews lead to?
- 9) What Diocese is St Mary's Church part of?

***Walk up the path through the church grounds.**

- 10) What is the phone number for Shakespeare Lodge?

***Walk along Back Street towards Mill Road.**

- 11) What does the tall red and white road sign say?

***Cross over Mill Road and continue on Back Street.**

12) How many green signs are there at the back of the pub?

13) What is the name of the house opposite Springfield Drive?

***Follow the road back down to the Lakenheath Village sign and walk back towards the play park.**

14) According to the sign, what other food does Trawlers Catch Traditional Fish and Chips sell?

15) On the sign at the start of Undley Road, how many miles is it to Beck Row?

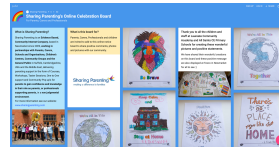
